Intake Process

Parents / Guardians will be contacted by ACTION staff once the student has been referred to the program. The student and parent/guardian will meet with ACTION staff to complete the enrollment process.

The student will be given a schedule of classes and information on how to connect to the APEX on-line system to access his or her classes and coursework.

The length of stay will vary based on each student's need. The staff will attempt to transition students back to their previous school of attendance at the end of a quarter or semester.

A transition plan will be created prior to a student's return to his or her previous school of attendance in order to maintain success. Parents / Guardians will be asked to participate in the transition program with the ACTION staff and student.
